

## **What to Expect When Arriving to Play Golf at Fiddler's**

The following is an explanation of our options and services that are provided to you by the golf valet attendants upon your arrival to the Club for a day of golf.

Upon arrival to the valet/bag drop area, you will be greeted by one of the professional valet attendants. They will remove your golf bag(s) from your car if they are not already stored in our bag storage room and place them on the bag drop rack. You may have your car valeted from here by an attendant. The option to have your car valeted is up to your discretion. If you choose to utilize our valet service, we will park your car in our designated valet lot, lock the car and then your keys will be stored on our valet key board. If you choose not to utilize our valet service, one of our staff members will direct you to the designated non-valet parking area.

From the valet circle, you will proceed into the Pro shop where you will check in at the desk with one of the Golf Professional Staff members. From the pro shop, you will be able to access the appropriate locker room and grill room if needed. From the pro shop, you will exit out the back of the pro shop and proceed towards the golf cart staging area/starter gazebo.

At the golf cart staging area/starter gazebo, you will be required to provide the starter with your receipt that you were given inside the pro shop. To ensure a timely start, please check in with the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your designated tee time. The exception to this would be if you wanted to utilize just the practice range/short game area. In this instance, tell the starter that you will not be playing but rather practicing and the starter will direct you where to go and how to get there. At this point, a golf staff member will load your golf bag(s) onto your cart and the starter will advise when you may depart for your designated course and/or practice area.

Player assistances will be seen periodically throughout the course to provide instructions, assistance and to monitor pace of play. Members and their guests are expected to maintain an acceptable pace of play (which will be outlined to you prior to beginning play). The player assistances will offer friendly reminders if the group finds itself out of position during the round. Please remember their job is to ensure that everyone enjoys their round of golf. If you or your guests have any questions during the course of play, please let the player assistances know and they will assist in any way that they can.

At the conclusion of your round, you will arrive back to the golf cart staging area/starter gazebo. One of the golf staff members will greet you and clean your golf clubs. If you valeted your car, one of the valet attendants will retrieve your car and place your clubs in it unless you wish to leave them at our facility and which point they will be placed in our bag storage room.
